Ted Unkles called the hearing to order at 6:15 p.m.

Sign Ordinance Hearing:

Alex Nuti-De Biasi asked about the meaning of corporate signs, if neon signage would be grandfathered, and how the Selectboard would enforce the measurement of wattage.

The Selectboard explained that the corporate sign section of the proposed ordinance is trying to prevent things such as a country store having a large Coca-Cola (or any other corporate name) sign in front of their store. The particular business Alex was suggesting had a neon sign has been out of business for longer than 30 days and therefore that particular neon sign would not be grandfathered. The Selectboard explained that they do not have a tool to measure wattage but referring to section 3 sub-section N, but the sign ordinance is trying to prevent really bright high wattage lights.
